Example #1

We provided a guided tour of historic Alexandria to a class of 45 eighth grade students that were in town for a Washington D.C. annual trip. We also provided them with a tour of the D.C. Monuments and Memorials along the National Mall.

A high school group of 35 students from Germany came to Washington D.C. for a week long immersion program in the United States. We provided a 1.5 hour Civil War tour with Alexandria as the backdrop to learn about this historic topic.
